ORDER DENYING MOTIONS

This is a pro se appeal from an order denying a postconviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus. On October 6, 2021, this court entered an order directing respondent to file an answering brief. Appellant has filed a motion for an extension of the time limit on the court's order for an answer and a motion for the appointment of appellate counsel. The motions are opposed. This court's order for an answering brief is directed at respondent, not appellant; appellant has no need for an extension and the motion is denied.

Appellant is not entitled to appointed counsel at the state's expense in postconviction proceedings. *See Brown v. McDaniel*, 130 Nev. 565, 331 P.3d 867 (2014); *see also Coleman v. Thompson*, 501 U.S. 722, 755 (1991). Accordingly, the motion for the appointment of counsel is denied.

It is so ORDERED.
