*ORDER DENYING MOTION*

Petitioners have filed a motion for leave to file a petition for writ of mandamus or prohibition in excess of the page and type-volume limitations. See NRAP 21(d) (providing that a petition may not exceed 15 pages or 7,000 words). The submitted petition consists of 53 pages and 12,235 words.

This court “looks with disfavor on motions to exceed the applicable page limit or type-volume limitation, and therefore, permission to exceed the page limit or type-volume limitation will not be routinely granted.” NRAP 32(a)(7)(D)(i). Having considered the motion and the submitted petition, this court is not convinced that petitioners demonstrate “diligence and good cause” warranting the filing of such a lengthy petition.

*See id.* ("A motion to file a brief that exceeds the applicable page limit or type-volume limitation will be granted only upon a showing of diligence and good cause."). Accordingly, the motion is denied.

The clerk shall strike the petition filed on July 15, 2020. Petitioners shall have 21 days from the date of this order to file and serve an amended petition that complies with the page or type-volume limitations of NRAP 21(d). Alternatively, petitioners may renew the motion to exceed the page or type-volume limitation within the same time period, if deemed warranted, provided that any such motion is accompanied by an amended petition that is significantly shorter and presents the facts and issues in a concise manner.

It is so ORDERED.
