**ORDER APPROVING STIPULATION**

The parties stipulation to extend the time to file the combined answering brief on appeal and opening brief on cross-appeal by 30 days and, additionally, to extend the time to file the combined reply briefs on appeal

and answering briefs on cross-appeal by 30 days is approved. NRAP 31(b)(2). Respondent/cross-appellant shall have until June 14, 2021, to file and serve the combined answering brief on appeal and opening brief on cross-appeal. Thereafter, appellants/cross-respondents shall have until August 13, 2021, to file the combined reply briefs on appeal and answering briefs on cross-appeal. Thereafter, briefing shall proceed in accordance with NRAP 28.1(f)(1)(D).

No further extensions of time shall be permitted absent demonstration of extraordinary circumstances and extreme need. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B). Counsel's caseload will not be deemed such a circumstance. *Cf. Varnum v. Grady*, 90 Nev. 374, 528 P.2d 1027 (1974). Failure to timely file the briefs may result in the imposition of sanctions.
