

## ORDER DIRECTING ANSWER

This original petition for a writ of mandamus or other extraordinary relief challenges a district court order denying petitioner's request for a preliminary injunction in a family law matter involving potential community property held in a spendthrift trust.

Having reviewed the petition, it appears that an answer may assist this court in resolving this matter. Therefore, real parties in interest,

on behalf of respondents, shall have 28 days from the date of this order to file and serve an answer, including authorities, against issuance of the requested writ. In addition to addressing the merits of the petition in its answer, real parties in interest should also address the propriety of writ relief. Petitioner shall have 14 days from service of the answer to file and serve any reply.

It is so ORDERED.
