NOW, THEREFORE, you are directed, in case number D-09-411537-D, entitled Eric L. Nelson, v. Lynita Sue Nelson, to vacate the order entered October 16, 2018, to the extent it found that the LSN and ELN Trusts were not parties to this action and to impose a Joint Preliminary Injunction over all trust property that remains subject to a claim of community interest, until a determination is made as to any community property.
