AMENDED SETTLEMENT PROGRAM STATUS REPORT

The undersigned Settlement Judge submits this amended status report to the Court --- which amends and supersedes yesterday's status report in this matter.

/ X / Other: In light of the undersigned's having become aware of Appellant's counsel's filing yesterday of a "Notice That No Settlement Has Been Reached In This Matter" --- which Notice was prepared and filed after and in response to the undersigned's then-accurate report to the Court of earlier in the day --- it now appears from the Notice that, while diligently discussing the same, the parties, have not as yet reached a final settlement of this matter, via an anticipated filing with the Court of a stipulation to dismiss this appeal --- in light of the Court's issuance of a Writ of Mandamus and Opinion of the Court, filed on May 6, 2021, in NV S.Ct. No. 81220 --- granting in part and denying in part the petition for said writ, the Notice in Lieu of Remittitur of which was filed on about June 1, 2021.

Accordingly, the undersigned recommends to the Court that this matter should remain in the Court's Settlement Program, for now, and that the time for the filing of a final report in this matter should be extended for an additional 30 days from the date of the filing of this amended status report.
