Defendant filed Gary Lewis Motion for Attorney s Fees and Costs on June 12, 2020. The matter was subsequently scheduled for hearing on August 5, 2020. After considering the pleadings and argument of counsel, the Court DENIES Defendant Gary Lewis Motion to Attorney s Fees and Costs. As to costs, [i]f the claim of the party intervening is not sustained, the party intervening shall pay all costs incurred by the intervention. NRS 12.130. However, the Nevada Supreme Court has held that [w]ithout evidence to determine whether a cost was reasonable and necessary, a district court may not award costs. Cadle Co. v. Woods & Erickson, LLP, 131 Nev. 114, 121 (2015). Here, the attached memorandum of costs provides no additional justifying documentation or evidence. Therefore, Defendant s motion is DENIED WITHOUT PREJUDICE as to the request for costs. As to attorney s fees, the Court finds they are not recoverable costs under NRS 12.130. Further, the Court finds UAIC did not maintain its position without reasonable ground or in bad faith so as to otherwise support an award of attorney s fees. 
