ORDER DENYING MOTION TO STRIKE AND ALTERNATIVE MOTION TO ENLARGE THE RECORD AND GRANTING MOTION TO CORRECT SUPPLEMENTAL APPENDIX

Appellant Gary Lewis has filed a motion to strike portions of respondent United Automobile Insurance Company's (UAIC) supplemental appendix on the ground that the challenged documents were not part of the record before the district court or are irrelevant. Lewis also filed an alternative motion to enlarge the record. UAIC filed a motion to correct the supplemental appendix and a combined reply to the motion to strike and alternative motion to enlarge the record and alternative motion for judicial notice.¹

¹UAIC filed a motion for an extension of time to file its reply on December 22, 2021. NRAP 26(b)(1). The motion is granted. The reply was filed on December 24, 2021.

SUPREME COURT OF NEVADA UAIC's unopposed motion to correct the supplemental appendix is granted. See NRAP 27. The corrected supplemental appendix, tab 2 (pages 65-345) was filed on December 24, 2021.

The motion to strike and alternative motion to enlarge the record are denied. With the correction to the supplemental appendix, it appears that the documents in the supplemental appendix are properly included in the record. NRAP 10(a).

It is so ORDERED.
