On October 6, 2020, this court entered an order adopting the Temporary Residential Summary Eviction Mediation Rules. Rule 11 provides that the summary eviction mediation program will sunset on May 31, 2021, unless funding for the program was exhausted before that date. On March 29, 2021, the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and Prevention extended its moratorium on residential evictions until June 30, 2021. The following day, Governor Sisolak issued Emergency Directive 43 extending Nevada's residential eviction moratorium to June 30, 2021. This court entered an order on April 8, 2021, extending the summary eviction mediation program and Rules.

The Nevada Supreme Court will conduct a public hearing on June 3, 2021, at 3:00 p.m. to assess the status of the Rules. There will be no physical location for this hearing.
