This court previously referred the parties to this appeal to the Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada for financial eligibility screening for the appointment of pro bono counsel in conjunction with the court's pro bono appellate program. The Legal Aid Center has now filed a motion informing this court that respondent has been determined to be eligible for the appointment of pro bono counsel and requesting an extension of time to find counsel to represent her.

The motion is granted. The Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada shall have until January 14, 2021, to locate volunteer counsel to represent respondent in this appeal. If a volunteer attorney cannot be located, the Legal Aid Center shall notify this court in writing within the same time frame.

The Legal Aid Center does not mention the status of the referral regarding counsel for appellant. If appellant qualifies for the appointment of pro bono counsel and does not object to such counsel, the Legal Aid Center shall also locate a volunteer attorney from the program to represent appellant. Once an attorney is located, the attorney shall file a notice of appearance in this court within 30 days from the date of this order. If appellant is not financially eligible or objects to pro bono representation, or
if a volunteer attorney cannot be located, the Legal Aid Center shall notify this court in writing within 30 days from the date of this order.

Briefing of this appeal remains suspended pending further order of this court.

It is so ORDERED.
