O R D E R

On December 15, 2020, this court entered an order granting the Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada's motion for an extension of time, until January 14, 2021, to locate volunteer counsel to represent respondent in this appeal. If a volunteer attorney could not be located, the Legal Aid Center was to notify this court, in writing, within the same time frame. The order also directed that if appellant qualifies for the appointment of pro bono counsel and does not object to such counsel, the Legal Aid Center was to locate a volunteer attorney from the program to represent appellant. Once an attorney was located, the attorney was to file a notice of appearance in this court by January 14, 2021. If appellant is not financially eligible or objects to pro bono representation, or if a volunteer attorney could not be located, the Legal Aid Center was to notify this court in writing by that same date.

To date, no attorney has filed a notice of appearance on behalf of appellant or respondent and the Legal Aid Center has not otherwise communicated with this court. The Legal Aid Center shall have 30 days from the date of this order to locate volunteer counsel to represent appellant and respondent in this appeal. If volunteer attorneys cannot be located, or if appellant is not financially eligible or objects to pro bono representation,

the Legal Aid Center shall notify this court in writing within the same time frame.

It is so ORDERED.
