RESPONDENT'S RESPONSE TO APPELLANTS' DOCKETING STATEMENT

Pursuant to NRAP 14(f), Respondent, The Regional Transportation Commission of Washoe County ("Respondent"), hereby responds to the Docketing Statement of Appellants, John Iliescu, Jr.; Sonnia Iliescu, Trustees of the John Iliescu Jr., and Sonnia Iliescu 1992 Family Trust Agreement, Dated January 23, 1992, (collectively "Appellants").

Respondent strongly disagrees with Appellants' statement of the case at pages 3-4. Specifically, Respondent disagrees that it "calculated a new deadline," made any "incorrect representation" to the district court, or that the district court relied upon any "incorrect calculation of days." Appellants never moved for an extension of the expert deadline, but made a request in their opposition to the motion in limine that they be granted "a 45-day extension of time in which to disclose their expert and submit his report in this case." The expert disclosure deadline was February 7, 2020, forty-five days after which was March 23, 2020. On March 27, 2020, Respondent notified the district court that no expert disclosure had been made by the requested extended deadline. This was an accurate statement and by no means did RTC "calculate a new deadline." Had Appellants believed this at the time, they should have filed a response in the nearly two months that followed prior to the district court entering its order on the motion in limine. As the district court pointed out in its
