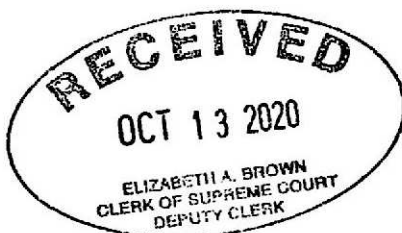


Settlement Judge
