

ORDER

Proposed amicus, Nevada Justice Association (NJA), has filed a motion for an extension of time to file a motion for leave to file an amicus brief in support of respondents. NRAP 26(b)(1)(A); NRAP 29(f). Appellants oppose the motion. The motion is granted to the following extent. NJA shall have until May 3, 2021, to file a motion for leave to file an amicus brief accompanied by the proposed brief. Appellants shall have until May 10, 2021, to file a response containing any arguments in opposition to the motion for leave in addition to those raised in their opposition to the motion for extension of time. Appellants shall have 30 days from the date that an order resolving the motion for leave to file a brief of amicus curiae is filed to file the reply brief.

Respondents' unopposed motion for an extension of time to file the answering brief is granted. The answering brief was filed on March 26, 2021.
