Trinity Advocates is a veteran-owned and operated non-profit organization under 26 U.S.C. § 501(c)(3) and a designated public charity under 26 U.S.C. § 170(b)(1)(A)(vi) dedicated to ensuring that military servicemembers, veterans, and their families have consistent, fair, and equal treatment under the Constitution and laws of the United States.

This Court's Order Granting Petition for Review, Directing Supplemental Briefing and Inviting Amicus Brief, filed on February 14, 2022 determined that the "participation of amicus curiae" may assist the "court's resolution of this matter." The Family Law Section of the State Bar of Nevada submitted a Motion for Extension of Time to File Amicus Curiae Brief on March 14, 2022 and Trinity Advocates submitted a Motion for Extension of Time to File Amicus Curiae Brief on March 28, 2022.

On March 31, 2022, the Court granted in part the motions filed by the Family Law Section of the State Bar of Nevada and Trinity Advocates and set a deadline of May 2, 2022 for the filing of any amicus curiae briefs. Subsequently, on April 15, 2022, an additional motion was filed by the American Academy of Matrimonial Lawyers to participate as amicus curiae.

While Trinity Advocates did not initially anticipate needing further extensions, Trinity Advocates requests an additional 7 days for the reasons below. Trinity Advocates still intends to file an amicus brief in this appeal, but must make new arrangements for counsel for sponsorship. This request for extension is made for good cause, and not for the purposes of delay, as it would allow Trinity Advocates to secure new sponsor counsel, fully review the case and issues on appeal, and finish preparing a submission that would aid the Court's resolution of the matter.

Accordingly, Trinity Advocates respectfully requests that this Court grant this Second Motion for Extension of Time to File Amicus Curiae Brief and provide an extension of time to file an amicus brief to May 9, 2022.
