

ORDER GRANTING STAY OF REMITTITUR

Appellant has moved to stay issuance of the remittitur pending the filing of a petition for a writ of certiorari with the United States Supreme Court. Respondent has filed a response indicating that she does not oppose a stay, but requests that appellant continue to comply with the district court order issued on December 31, 2020, directing appellant to make monthly payments to an attorney's trust account. Appellant filed a reply indicating that he does not oppose the stay being conditioned on his continued compliance with the December 31, 2020, order.¹ The motion for a stay is granted to the following extent. *See* NRAP 41(b). Issuance of the remittitur shall be stayed until September 11, 2023. If the clerk of this court receives written notice by September 11, 2023, from the clerk of the

¹Appellant argues that respondent's request expands the scope of the December 31, 2020, order by requesting that payments be made on the 5th of every month. The order does not set a date for when payments are due, but rather instructs appellant's attorney to provide a monthly account statement to respondent's attorney within 5 days of the payment.
