## MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE AMICUS BRIEF OF THE NEVADA JUSTICE ASSOCIATION (First Request)

The Nevada Justice Association ("NJA"), an *amicus curiae*, is a non-profit organization of independent lawyers in the State of Nevada. The *amicus curiae* is represented by Micah S. Echols, Esq., of Claggett & Sykes Law Firm, and Thomas W. Stewart, Esq., of The Powell Law Firm in this matter, hereby moves this Court pursuant to NRAP 26(1)(a) for a motion for extension of time of 30 days from the Court's order to file its amicus brief.
