*ORDER GRANTING MOTION*

Respondent has filed an unopposed motion for leave to file an unredacted answering brief and portions of a supplemental appendix under seal. Respondent has also (1) filed a redacted answering brief, (2) filed an appendix containing a document that it does not seek to seal and (3) submitted a version of the appendix containing both the document in the filed appendix and a document it seeks to file under seal.

Leave of this court is required to file a redacted brief. Accordingly, respondent's motion is construed as also seeking leave to file a redacted answering brief. The motion is granted to the following extent. SRCR 7. The redacted answering brief was filed on May 24, 2021. The clerk shall file the unredacted answering brief and appendix received on May 25, 2021, under seal.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup>Counsel for respondent is advised that a respondent's appendix should be paginated beginning with page 1. It should not be paginated as a continuation of appellant's appendix. The incorrect page numbering is excused in this instance. NRAP 2.

Appellant shall have until June 23, 2021, to file and serve any reply brief. Failure to file a timely reply brief may be treated as a waiver of the right to file a reply brief. NRAP 28(c).
