



ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW

Appellant's pro bono counsel has filed a motion to withdraw. In support, counsel explains that he does not believe appellant has any viable appellate issues. Cause appearing, the motion is granted. NRAP 46(e)(3). The clerk shall remove Nicholas R. Shook as counsel of record for appellant. This appeal shall proceed with appellant in pro se.

Appellant filed the fast track statement and an addendum on November 3, 2020.¹ Accordingly, respondents shall have 21 days from the date of this order to file and serve their fast track responses. Failure to timely file and serve a fast track response may result in the imposition of sanctions. NRAP 3E(d)(2), (i).

It is so ORDERED.
