*ORDER DENYING MOTIONS TO DISQUALIFY, FOR
RECONSIDERATION, AND FOR STAY*

These are consolidated pro se appeals from (1) a district court order granting respondent sole legal and primary physical custody of the parties' minor child, allowing respondent to relocate with the child, and determining child support obligations; and (2) a district court order awarding attorney fees.

Three of appellants' motions are currently before the court. First, appellant seeks to disqualify respondent's former and current counsel, asserting that former counsel committed perjury and a fraud upon the court and that current counsel is merely a "front" for former counsel. Second, appellant asks this court to reconsider its June 4, 2021, order denying a stay of the district court custody order. And third, appellant seeks an emergency stay of the child support portions of the custody order.

Having reviewed these three motions, they are denied, as appellant has not demonstrated any legal basis for the relief requested or that the NRAP 8 factors weigh in favor of a stay.

It is so ORDERED.
