ORDER


Cause appearing, the motion for an extension of time to file the answering brief is granted. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B). Respondent shall have until March 22, 2022, to file and serve the answering brief. Given the length of this initial extension request, no further extensions shall be permitted absent extraordinary circumstances and extreme need. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B). Counsel's caseload normally will not be deemed such a circumstance. *Cf. Varnum v. Grady*, 90 Nev. 374, 528 P.2d 1027 (1974). Failure to timely file the answering brief may result in the imposition of sanctions, including the resolution of this appeal without an answering brief. *See* NRAP 31(d).

On January 12, 2022, attorneys Eric D. Hone, Joel Z. Schwarz and Jamie L. Zimmerman of Hone Law filed a notice of appearance as counsel of record for Lone Mountain Partners, LLC (Lone Mountain).

Appellants have not named Lone Mountain as a respondent in this appeal. Accordingly, the clerk of this court shall add attorneys Hone, Schwarz, and Zimmerman and Hone Law to the docket for notice purposes only. If Lone Mountain believes it is a proper party to this appeal, it may file a motion to be added as a respondent, explaining why it is a proper respondent.

This court takes no action in regard to Lone Mountain's joinder in respondent's motion to extend the time to file the answering brief.

It is so ORDERED.
