DECLARATION OF VICTORIA T. OLDENBURG

1. I am an attorney dully licensed to practice law in the State of Nevada and am the appointed counsel of Appellant Katherine D. Fletcher on her direct appeal of her conviction currently pending before this Honorable Court. Appellant was convicted by a jury of first degree murder with the use of a deadly weapon and is serving a prison term of life without the possibility of parole.

2. Appellant's Opening Brief and Appendix are currently due August 2, 2021.

3. Appellant recently requested that I provide her with copies of the transcripts in her case so that she can assist in her direct appeal. I am in the process of arranging for the transcripts to be copied and mailed to Appellant at her current place of incarceration, Florence McClure Women's Correctional Center.

4. I have corresponded with Appellant regarding the process of a direct appeal. However, based upon the letter of July 7, 2021 that Appellant filed with this Court I believe it will be necessary for me to personally meet with Appellant to go over her case and any issues I have identified to be raised on direct appeal. Appellant has informed this Court that she will be transferred to Northern Nevada Correctional Center in early August, which will give me an opportunity to personally meet with Appellant to discuss her case.

5. Therefore, I am requesting an additional thirty (30) day extension of time within which to file the Opening Brief and Appendices, up to and including September 1, 2021.

6. I spoke with Appellate Deputy Marilee Cate, attorney for Respondent, and she does not oppose this Motion.

7. This Motion for Extension of Time is made in good faith and not for the purpose of delay or other improper purpose.
