ORDER REGARDING MOTIONS

Cause appearing, appellant's motion requesting a second extension of time to file the opening brief is granted. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B). Appellant shall have until October 18, 2021, to file and serve the opening brief and appendix. No further extensions of time shall be permitted absent demonstration of extraordinary circumstances and extreme need. *Id.* Counsel's caseload normally will not be deemed such a circumstance. *Cf. Varnum v. Grady*, 90 Nev. 374, 528 P.2d 1027 (1974). Failure to timely file the opening brief and appendix may result in the imposition of sanctions.

Appellant has filed a pro se motion for a "Young hearing" if the deadline to file the opening brief has not been extended. As the motion for an extension of time has been granted, the pro se motion is denied.
