You might wonder 'what is to stop her from pursuing these issues once she's out?' I assure you I have zero desire to step one foot inside any government facility ever again after I step out of this one! I do understand your fears, but trust me - there is much more to fear at keeping me here. I understand your fears, and want to relieve them. It's all logistics. We're all intelligent people who can work out problems wisely over an off-the-record discussion. My course has not changed, and I'd like to go home now.
