ORDER

This appeal was docketed on November, 9, 2020, with the filing of a pro se notice of appeal. On March 2, 2021, attorney Jean J. Schwartz entered a notice of appearance on behalf of appellant.

As appellant is now represented by counsel, this court sets the following deadlines for filing documents. Appellant shall have 14 days from the date of this order to file and serve a docketing statement and to file a transcript request form. *See* NRAP 9. If no transcripts are to be requested, appellant shall file a notice to that effect within the same time period. *Id.* Appellant shall have 90 days from the date of this order to file and serve an opening brief.¹ Thereafter, briefing shall proceed in accordance with NRAP 31(a)(1).

It is so ORDERED.
