ORDER

These are appeals from several postjudgment orders involving possible relocation of the minor child that are related and collateral to the issues already briefed in Docket No. 81515. On May 6, 2021, this court entered an order reinstating the briefing for these appeals, and directing that they be clustered with Docket No. 81515.¹ Appellant has filed a motion proposing that briefing for these appeals be suspended pending resolution of Docket No. 81515 because the fundamental issues in all three cases are duplicative and have already been briefed and because any disposition in Docket No. 81515 is likely to render the instant appeals moot. Respondent has not filed any response.

The motion to suspend briefing in the instant appeals is granted. The briefing schedule in these appeals shall be suspended pending

further order of this court. Within 60 days of the date of this order, the parties shall file a status report regarding the status of the proceedings in these consolidated appeals and in the related appeal in Docket No. 81515.
