# MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

### A. Facts

Appellants VINCE and ERICA BARTELLO are small business owners who operate a Mobile Billboard service in the Las Vegas area. This is an appeal taken from a Judgement

following a Jury Trial in the underlying action, Sean Fitzgerald v. Hillsboro Enterprises, Inc. et al, A-15-716570-C. The Notice of Appeal was filed on September 27, 2019. Thereafter, the matter was placed in the Settlement Program. A settlement was not reached and therefore the matter was place back on a briefing schedule.

On July 24, 2020 the Appellants filed their Opening Brief and Appendix. On September 8, 2020 the Respondents filed their Answering Brief. A Notice of Deficient Brief was filed and a corrected Answering Brief was filed the next day on September 9, 2020. The Reply Brief was due on October 9, 2020. The Appellants received a Two(2) week telephonic extension to file the Reply Brief.

The Appellants are requesting an additional Two (2) weeks extension, to November 7, 2020, to file their Reply Brief. One (1) of our staff members has been diagnosed with Covid-19, along with her father. This staff member was present in the office and could have infected other staff members. Additionally, much of our staff is related to each other increasing the chances of Covid-19 infection. Our firm's paralegal has already developed Covid-19 symptoms and is quarantining herself and her husband (who is also an employee of Hurtik Law & Associates) and awaiting test results.
