

*ORDER DENYING MOTION*

Appellant has filed a pro se "Emergency Motion Pursuant to NRAP 27E [sic] to Enforce Appellant's Rights Pursuant to the US Constitution and Restraining Order Restricting Angela Ochoa and Lipson Neilson From Vexatious Litigation and Handling Any Monies in this Matter and Demand for Pro Bono Counsel Pursuant to 18 USC Section 3771 and Motion for Full Briefing Due to Fraud on District Court.
