¹ This challenged order in this matter was issued by Judge Kerry Earley after the case had been transferred to Judge Mark Denton.

Appellant, by and through its counsel of record, the law firm of Snell & Wilmer L.L.P., hereby move for an additional one-week extension of time to file its reply in support of its motion for reconsideration. The reply is currently due for filing on April 2, 2021, following a fourteen-day extension pursuant to NRAP 26(b)(1)(B) and one-week extension by motion. Appellant respectfully requests a modest extension until April 9, 2020 pursuant to NRAP 27 and NRAP 31. While counsel had previously obtained extensions totaling 21 days, a short additional extension is needed to fully brief this matter and for adequate time for client review. The local school district's recess of six business days combined with the holidays this week and weekend resulted in restricted availability in the days leading up to the deadline, particularly as childcare options are limited due to continuing pandemic circumstances. Counsel represents that they intend to seek no additional extensions.
