## MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE OPENING BRIEF (FIRST REQUEST BY MOTION)

Appellant, by and through its counsel of record, the law firm of Snell & Wilmer L.L.P., hereby moves for a two-week extension of time to file its Opening Brief in support of its motion for reconsideration. The Brief is currently due for filing on June 8, 2021, following a fourteen-day extension pursuant to NRAP 26(b)(1)(B). Appellant respectfully requests an additional extension until June 22, 2021 pursuant to NRAP 27 and NRAP 31. An additional extension is needed to fully brief this matter and for adequate time for client review. Notably, the entire length of extension sought for the Brief still totals only 28 days, which is less than the length of extension permitted by stipulation of the parties (along with the approval of the Court).

The primary reason for undersigned counsel's need for the requested additional time is that her minor child suffered an injury at a sporting event on Thursday, May 27, which affected her ability to work on Friday, May 28. The injury was diagnosed as a fractured patella (broken kneecap) following the holiday weekend on Tuesday, June 1, and has required time-consuming diagnostic and medical appointments, as well as supporting his limited mobility. In light of this injury and the time it has demanded from undersigned counsel, Appellant respectfully requests an additional 14 days to allow sufficient time to complete the Brief and allow for client review.

Counsel represents that they intend to seek no additional extensions and intends to file on June 22, 2021.
