**(d) Notice of Appeal.** An appeal to the Supreme Court from a commission order shall be taken by filing a notice of appeal with the clerk of the commission and serving a copy of the notice on the prosecuting counsel, if any. Filing and service must be made within 30 days after service on the respondent of the commission's formal order of suspension, censure, removal, retirement, or other discipline, together with its formal findings of fact and conclusions of law. Upon the filing of the notice of appeal, the clerk of the commission shall immediately transmit to the clerk of the Supreme Court 2 file-stamped copies of the notice of appeal.
