



ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

On April 28, 2021, this court entered an order adopting standardized forms related to the protection of children from abuse and neglect. The order directed the use of the standardized forms to become mandatory in all child abuse and neglect cases in Nevada on January 1, 2022. Due to staffing and training challenges within the Clark County District Attorney's Office, two additional extensions were granted, extending the effective date for the mandatory use of the standardized forms to June 1, 2023. On September 12, 2023, the Honorable David S. Gibson, Jr., Eighth Judicial District Court, Family Division, and the Clark County District Attorney's Office submitted a letter indicating that they are prepared to implement the mandatory use of the standardized forms on October 16, 2023. Cause appearing, the effective date of the mandatory use of the standardized forms in the Eighth Judicial District Court shall be extended to October 16, 2023.

It is so ORDERED.
