

ORDER

Appellant has filed a motion to forgive the failure to timely file the transcript request form and opening brief and appendix and for an extension of time to file those documents. No motion to forgive an untimely filing is necessary and thus no action will be taken on that portion of the motion. Regarding the motion for an extension of time, the motion is denied because it does not comply with NRAP 27(a)(2) (requiring a motion to state with particularity the relief sought) and NRAP 31(b)(3)(A) (listing requirements for a motion for an extension of time to file a brief).

Appellant shall have 7 days from the date of this order to serve and file, in this court, a file-stamped transcript request form in compliance with NRAP 9(a), and the opening brief and appendix. Failure to timely comply with this order may result in the imposition of sanctions, including the dismissal of this appeal. NRAP 9(a)(7); NRAP 31(d).
