***ORDER TO FILE TRANSCRIPT REQUEST FORM AND  
OPENING BRIEF AND APPENDIX***

On September 14, 2021, this court entered an order denying appellant's motion for an extension of time and directing appellant to serve and file, in this court, a file-stamped transcript request form in compliance with NRAP 9(a) and the opening brief and appendix within 7 days. This court cautioned that failure to timely comply could result in the imposition of sanctions, including the dismissal of this appeal. NRAP 9(a)(7); NRAP 31(d). Appellant filed the opening brief and appendix on September 21, 2021. However, those documents were rejected by the clerk of this court on that same date because they were not signed by counsel of record. *See* NRAP 25(a)(5). The clerk directed appellant to re-file the documents and a notice of appearance within 5 days. On September 22, 2021, counsel filed a notice of appearance. To date, however, counsel has not re-filed the opening brief and appendix, filed the transcript request form, or otherwise communicated with this court.

Appellant shall have 7 days from the date of this order to serve and file, in this court, a file-stamped transcript request form in compliance

with NRAP 9(a), and the opening brief and appendix.<sup>1</sup> Failure to timely comply with this order will result in the imposition of sanctions that may include the dismissal of this appeal. NRAP 9(a)(7); NRAP 31(d).

It is so ORDERED.
