ORDER GRANTING MOTION

Respondents have filed a motion to associate attorney Jacob Zvi Goldstein of Hall, Prangle & Schoonveld, pursuant to SCR 42. Attached to the motion to associate Mr. Goldstein is a verified application, a certificate of good standing from the Supreme Court of the State of Illinois, and a statement pursuant to SCR 42 from the State Bar of Nevada. The State Bar of Nevada's Rule 42 statement indicates that Mr. Goldstein has applied once to appear in Nevada courts within the past 3 years. *See* SCR 42(6) (stating that repeated appearances by any person pursuant to this rule shall be cause for denial of the motion). Accordingly, the motion to associate is granted. SCR 42(8). Mr. Goldstein shall be permitted to appear on behalf of respondents in this matter. Nevada attorney Michael Prangle of Hall, Prangle & Schoonveld shall be responsible for all matters presented by Mr. Goldstein in this matter. *See* SCR 42(14)(a) (requiring the Nevada attorney of record to be responsible for and actively participate in the representation

of a client in these proceedings); NRAP 25(a)(5) (requiring all documents submitted to the supreme court for filing to include the original signature of at least one attorney of record who is an active member of the State Bar of Nevada); NRAP 46(a)(3) (requiring Nevada counsel to sign all briefs, be present during oral argument, and be responsible for all briefs and matters presented by foreign counsel).
