***ORDER GRANTING IN PART MOTION TO EXPEDITE AND
REGARDING BRIEFING***

Appellant has filed a motion to expedite this appeal.¹ Having considered the motion, opposition, and reply, the motion is granted in part. The briefing and disposition of this appeal will be expedited as described below.

It appears from the parties' filings that they disagree whether this appeal is moot. Therefore, the parties shall include in their briefs a discussion, including points and authorities, of whether this appeal is moot and is justiciable by this court. The discussion should contain separate analysis for each of the orders challenged on appeal. Because appellant has already filed his opening brief, he shall have 7 days from the date of this order to file and serve a supplemental opening brief containing the mootness analysis directed herein. Respondents shall have 14 days from service of the supplemental opening brief to file and serve their answering

briefs.² Appellant shall have 5 days from service of the last-filed answering brief to file and serve any reply brief. Appellant may expedite the briefing process further by filing his supplemental brief and/or reply brief in advance of the due dates. This court will expedite the disposition of this appeal once briefing is completed to the extent permitted by its docket.
