#### <u>ARRAIGNMENT</u>

Hearing conducted via Zoom audiovisual conferencing.

Deputy D.A. Brittany Bishop represented the State.

Defendant was present with counsel, Jay Slocum, Deputy P.D.

Probation Specialist, M. Staveness, was present.

The Court made a record of the fact that this hearing was being held remotely because of the closure of the courthouse at 75 Court Street, in Reno, Washoe County, Nevada, due to the National and local emergency caused by COVID-19. The Court and all participants appeared via simultaneous audiovisual transmission. The Court was physically located in Washoe County, Nevada which was the site of the court session. At the direction of the Court, all participants stated their appearances and location.

Respective counsel acknowledged receipt of notice that the hearing was taking place pursuant to the Second Judicial District Court's Administrative Orders entered in 2020, and the Nevada Supreme Court Rules - Part IX governing appearances by simultaneous audiovisual transmissions, and counsel stated they had no objection to proceeding in this manner.

The Court further made a record of the fact that these proceedings are open to the public for viewing and listening through the webinar/meeting invitation located on the Court's website and directed that if at any time anyone who is participating in this matter cannot see or hear the other participants in this case, they are to inform the Court.

TRUE NAME: **TRAVIS WILLIAM BISH**. Defendant was in receipt of a copy of the Information, waived formal reading and pled Guilty to **Attempted Lewdness With a Child Less Than 14 Years of Age**, as charged in the Information.

Counsel for Defendant stated plea negotiations to the Court. At the direction of the Court, the Defendant was placed under oath; Defendant executed the Guilty Plea Memorandum (GPM) during these proceedings and provided the Court with visual proof of Defendant's signature.

In response to the Court, Defendant confirmed that defense counsel had reviewed the GPM with Defendant and had answered all questions Defendant had regarding said document. The Court canvassed the Defendant, informed him of his rights and stated possible penalties to the Defendant.

6/30/21 9:00 a.m. Sentencing Counsel for State stated elements of the charge the State was prepared to prove at the time of trial.

Court made a finding that the Defendant is aware of his rights and knowingly waives them, that there is a factual basis for the entry of plea and the Court accepts the plea and enters a formal finding of guilt on the record.

**COURT ORDERED:** Matter continued for entry of judgment and imposition of sentence. The Court ordered a P.S.I. Report and directed Defendant to be prepared to pay the Administrative Assessment Fee at time of sentencing.

Defendant was remanded to the custody of the Sheriff.
