THE COURT: The next case is State versus
Travis Bish: CR20-2911.

MS. BISHOP: Good morning, Your Honor.

Brittany Bishop, for the State, located here in Washoe County, Nevada. I've received all applicable notices and I have no objection to appearing in this format.

THE COURT: Good morning. Jay Slocum, on behalf of Mr. Bish, located in Washoe County, Nevada. We are familiar with the relevant rules and we have no objection to going forward in this fashion this morning.

THE COURT: Very good. Ms. Slocum, I've got an Information that's filed April 26th, 2021. I'll ask is your client's name correctly spelled and whether he'd like to have that read.

MR. SLOCUM: Thank you, Your Honor. We are familiar with the Information that's been filed in this case. We're going to waive a formal reading, and I will defer to Mr. Bish with regard to his middle name.

THE COURT: I don't have a middle name on my --

MR. SLOCUM: Correct. If he has a middle

1 name, I'm not -- I'm letting the Court know I'll defer to
2 Mr. Bish if he has a middle name.

3 THE COURT: Mr. Bish, do you have a middle
4 name?

5 THE DEFENDANT: Yes. It's William.

6 THE COURT: All right. We'll add William to
7 his middle name. And now you know, Mr. Slocum. You
8 don't have to ask him anymore. His name is now William.
9 We know that.

10 MR. SLOCUM: Thank you very much. I
11 appreciate that.

12 THE COURT: All right. Let me know if
13 there's any negotiations in this case.

14 MR. SLOCUM: Thank you, Your Honor.
15 Mr. Bish, as I understand it, is agreeing to plead guilty
16 to the offense of attempted lewdness with a child less
17 than 14 years of age. That's a category B felony as more
18 fully alleged in the Information filed in this case.

19 In exchange for his plea of guilty, both
20 parties are going to be free to argue. I have discussed
21 with Mr. Bish that he will only be eligible for probation
22 if a psychosexual evaluation certifies that he is not a
23 high risk to re-offend. However, even if he is so
24 certified, it will be at the Court's discretion whether

1 or not he receives probation.

2 Additionally, we have discussed the fact that
3 he will have to register pursuant to this conviction as
4 well as the lifetime supervision component.

5 THE COURT: Thank you. And you waived a
6 formal reading of the Information too, right?

7 MR. SLOCUM: Yes, Your Honor. And the only
8 other thing is that the State is agreeing not to pursue
9 any transactionally-related charges or enhancements.

10 THE COURT: Very good. Correct statement,
11 Ms. Bishop?

12 MS. BISHOP: Sure is.

13 THE COURT: All right. Swear in the
14 defendant please, Mr. Clerk.

15 THE CLERK: Yes, Your Honor. Mr. Bish,
16 please raise your right hand.

17 (The defendant was sworn.)

18 THE COURT: Do you agree with the
19 negotiations of your case described to the Court by your
20 counsel?

21 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

22 THE COURT: How old are you?

23 THE DEFENDANT: Thirty-two.

24 THE COURT: Read and write the English

1 language?

2 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

3 THE COURT: How far did you get in school?

4 THE DEFENDANT: Tenth grade.

5 THE COURT: Did you read and understand the
6 Plea Memorandum in this case?

7 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

8 THE COURT: Discuss the Plea Memorandum with
9 your attorney?

10 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

11 THE COURT: Completely understand all of its
12 terms and conditions?

13 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

14 THE COURT: Do you have that document in
15 front of you?

16 THE DEFENDANT: Yes, I do.

17 THE COURT: Would you turn to the last page
18 and date it and sign it for me and show it to me once
19 you've done so? Let me see that. Very good. I see your
20 signature. Did you have an opportunity to speak with
21 Mr. Slocum about it and he did he answer your questions
22 to your satisfaction?

23 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

24 THE COURT: Very good. Are you in agreement

1 with all of the provisions contained in the Plea
2 Memorandum?

3 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

4 THE COURT: Do you understand by pleading
5 guilty, you give up important constitutional rights?

6 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

7 THE COURT: Do you understand you give up
8 your right to a jury trial to be conducted within 60 days
9 of today when you plead guilty?

10 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

11 THE COURT: Do you understand by pleading
12 guilty, you're giving up your right to require the State
13 to prove the charges against you beyond a reasonable
14 doubt?

15 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

16 THE COURT: Do you understand you're giving
17 up your right to confront your accusers by pleading
18 guilty?

19 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

20 THE COURT: Do you understand by pleading
21 guilty, you're giving up your right against
22 self-incrimination?

23 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

24 THE COURT: By admitting these charges, you

1 are incriminating yourself. Do you understand that?

2 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

3 THE COURT: Do you understand you give up the
4 right to cross-examine all of the State's witnesses who
5 would be called against you at trial?

6 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

7 THE COURT: And you understand you're giving
8 up your right to subpoena witnesses and compel the
9 attendance of those witnesses in court at the time of
10 trial?

11 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

12 THE COURT: At this time, Ms. Bishop,
13 representing the State of Nevada as its Deputy District
14 Attorney, will tell you what the State would be prepared
15 to prove beyond a reasonable doubt if the case were to go
16 to trial.

17 Ms. Bishop?

18 MS. BISHOP: That on or about August 22nd,
19 2020, at or about 1475 Vista Del Rancho Drive, apartment
20 266, within the County of Washoe, State of Nevada, you
21 did willfully, unlawfully and lewdly attempt to commit a
22 lewd or lascivious act upon or with the body of A.I., a
23 female child under the age of 14 years, at the time the
24 act was committed in that you did attempt to touch the

1 child victim's vagina with your hand and/or fingers.

2 THE COURT: Do you understand the elements
3 the State was prepared to prove against you should this
4 matter go to trial?

5 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

6 THE COURT: Did you commit the crime with the
7 intent as described in the charges stated by the Deputy
8 District Attorney?

9 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

10 THE COURT: Do you understand the penalties
11 are that you may be imprisoned for a period of two to 20
12 years Nevada Department of Corrections. You're not
13 eligible for probation unless a psychosexual evaluation
14 is completed pursuant to statute which certifies you do
15 not represent a high risk to re-offend based upon a
16 currently-accepted standard of assessment.

17 Do you further understand that you'll be
18 required to be on lifetime supervision pursuant to
19 statute and you will be required to register as a sex
20 offender pursuant to statute? Do you understand all of
21 those penalties?

22 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

23 THE COURT: All right. Do you understand I'm
24 not bound by the recommendation of the parties? Only the

1 Court alone will determine your sentence?

2 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

3 THE COURT: Do you realize that may result in
4 your incarceration in the Nevada Department of
5 Corrections?

6 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

7 THE COURT: With all of those rights in mind
8 you've given up and all of the information the Court has
9 provided to you, do you still wish to plead guilty?

10 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

11 THE COURT: Have you had sufficient time to
12 discuss this case with your attorney?

13 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

14 THE COURT: Are you satisfied with the
15 representation provided to you by your attorney leading
16 up to this plea?

17 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

18 THE COURT: Has anyone promised you anything
19 in order to get you to plead guilty?

20 THE DEFENDANT: No.

21 THE COURT: Has anyone threatened you or your
22 family in order to get you to plead guilty?

23 THE DEFENDANT: No.

24 THE COURT: Are you pleading guilty freely

1 and voluntarily?

2 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

3 THE COURT: Are you under the influence of
4 any alcohol, drugs or medications today which would
5 affect your ability to understand what's happening today
6 in court?

7 THE DEFENDANT: No.

8 THE COURT: Do you have any questions for me
9 about this case or these proceedings?

10 THE DEFENDANT: No, Your Honor.

11 THE COURT: What is your plea?

12 THE DEFENDANT: I plead guilty.

13 THE COURT: I find you understand the nature
14 of the offense charged, the consequence of your plea.
15 You've made a knowing, voluntary, intelligent waiver of
16 your constitutional rights. I'll accept your plea.
17 We'll set a date for sentencing.

18 At that time, you'll be expected to pay a \$25
19 administrative assessment fee. You're ordered to
20 cooperate with the Division of Parole and Probation.
21 They'll prepare a presentence report that will assist me
22 at the time of sentencing. Do you understand those last
23 two orders?

24 THE DEFENDANT: Yes.

1 THE COURT: Very good. Date for sentencing,
2 please?

3 THE CLERK: Yes, Your Honor. That will be
4 June 23rd, at 9:00 a.m.

5 THE COURT: Very good.

6 MR. SLOCUM: Could we with go another week,
7 please? I've got another commitment that day.

8 THE CLERK: Yes, Your Honor. We can go June
9 30th at 9:00 a.m.

10 MR. SLOCUM: Thank you very much.

19 GUILTY PLEA MEMORANDUM

20 1. I, TRAVIS BISH, understand that I am charged with the
21 offense of: ATTEMPTED LEWDNESS WITH A CHILD LESS THAN 14 YEARS OF
22 AGE, a violation of NRS 193.330, being an attempt to violate NRS
23 201.230, a category B felony.

24 2. I desire to enter a plea of guilty to the offense of,
25 ATTEMPTED LEWDNESS WITH A CHILD LESS THAN 14 YEARS OF AGE, a
26 violation of NRS 193.330, being an attempt to violate NRS 201.230, a
category B felony, as more fully alleged in the charge filed against
me.

1 3. By entering my plea of guilty I know and understand
2 that I am waiving the following constitutional rights:

3 A. I waive my privilege against self-incrimination.

4 B. I waive my right to trial by jury, at which trial the
5 State would have to prove my guilt of all elements of the offense
6 beyond a reasonable doubt.

7 C. I waive my right to confront my accusers, that is, the
8 right to confront and cross examine all witnesses who would testify
9 at trial.

10 D. I waive my right to subpoena witnesses for trial on my
11 behalf.

12 4. I understand the charge against me and that the
13 elements of the offense which the State would have to prove beyond a
14 reasonable doubt at trial are that on or about August 22, 2020, at or
15 about 1475 Vista Del Rancho Drive, Apt #266, within the County of
16 Washoe, State of Nevada, I did willfully, unlawfully and lewdly
17 attempt to commit a lewd or lascivious act upon or with the body of
18 A.I., a female child under the age of 14 years at the time the act
19 was committed, in that I attempted to touch the child victim's vagina
20 with my hand and/or finger(s).

21 5. I understand that I admit the facts which support all
22 the elements of the offense by pleading guilty. I admit that the
23 State possesses sufficient evidence which would result in my
24 conviction. I have considered and discussed all possible defenses
25 and defense strategies with my counsel. I understand that I have the
26 right to appeal from adverse rulings on pretrial motions only if the

1 State and the Court consent to my right to appeal in a separate
2 written agreement. I understand that any substantive or procedural
3 pretrial issue(s) which could have been raised at trial are waived by
4 my plea.

5 6. I understand that the consequences of my plea of guilty
6 are that I may be imprisoned for a period of 2 to 20 years in the
7 Nevada State Department of Corrections. I am not eligible for
8 probation unless a psychosexual evaluation is completed pursuant to
9 NRS 176.139 which certifies that I do not represent a high risk to
10 reoffend based upon a currently accepted standard of assessment. I
11 further understand that I will be required to be on lifetime
12 supervision pursuant to NRS 176.0931. Lastly, I understand I will be
13 required to register as a sex offender pursuant to NRS Chapter 179D.

14 7. In exchange for my plea of guilty, the State, my
15 counsel and I have agreed to recommend the following: The Parties
16 will be free to argue for an appropriate sentence. The State will
17 not pursue any other criminal charges arising out of this transaction
18 or occurrence.

19 8. I understand that, even though the State and I have
20 reached this plea agreement, the State is reserving the right to
21 present arguments, facts, and/or witnesses at sentencing in support
22 of the plea agreement.

23 ///

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1 9. I also agree that I will make full restitution in this
2 matter, as determined by the Court. Where applicable, I additionally
3 understand and agree that I will be responsible for the repayment of
4 any costs incurred by the State or County in securing my return to
5 this jurisdiction.

6 10. I understand that the State, at their discretion, is
7 entitled to either withdraw from this agreement and proceed with the
8 prosecution of the original charges or be free to argue for an
9 appropriate sentence at the time of sentencing if I fail to appear at
10 any scheduled proceeding in this matter OR if prior to the date of my
11 sentencing I am arrested in any jurisdiction for a violation of law
12 OR if I have misrepresented my prior criminal history. I understand
13 and agree that the occurrence of any of these acts constitutes a
14 material breach of my plea agreement with the State. I further
15 understand and agree that by the execution of this agreement, I am
16 waiving any right I may have to remand this matter to Justice Court
17 should I later withdraw my plea.

18 11. I understand and agree that pursuant to the terms of
19 the plea agreement stated herein, any counts which are to be
20 dismissed and any other cases charged or uncharged which are either
21 to be dismissed or not pursued by the State, may be considered by the
22 court at the time of my sentencing.

23 12. I understand that the Court is not bound by the
24 agreement of the parties and that the matter of sentencing is to be
25 determined solely by the Court. I have discussed the charge, the
26 facts and the possible defenses with my attorney. All of the

1 foregoing rights, waiver of rights, elements, possible penalties, and
2 consequences, have been carefully explained to me by my attorney. My
3 attorney has not promised me anything not mentioned in this plea
4 memorandum, and, in particular, my attorney has not promised that I
5 will get any specific sentence. I am satisfied with my counsel's
6 advice and representation leading to this resolution of my case. I
7 am aware that if I am not satisfied with my counsel I should advise
8 the Court at this time. I believe that entering my plea is in my
9 best interest and that going to trial is not in my best interest. My
10 attorney has advised me that if I wish to appeal, any appeal, if
11 applicable to my case, must be filed within thirty days of my
12 sentence and/or judgment.

13 13. I understand that this plea and resulting conviction
14 will likely have adverse effects upon my residency in this country if
15 I am not a U. S. Citizen. I have discussed the effects my plea will
16 have upon my residency with my counsel.

17 14. I offer my plea freely, voluntarily, knowingly and
18 with full understanding of all matters set forth in the Information
19 and in this Plea Memorandum. I have read this plea memorandum
20 completely and I understand everything contained within it.

21 15. My plea of guilty is voluntary and is not the result
22 of any threats, coercion or promises of leniency.

23 16. I am signing this Plea Memorandum voluntarily with
24 advice of counsel, under no duress, coercion, or promises of
25 leniency.

15 JUDGMENT OF CONVICTION

16 The Defendant having entered a plea of Guilty, and no sufficient cause being
17 shown by Defendant as to why judgment should not be pronounced against him, the Court
18 rendered judgment as follows:

19 That Travis William Bish is guilty of the crime of Attempted Lewdness With a
20 Child Less Than 14 Years of Age, a violation of NRS 193.330, being an attempt to violate
21 NRS 201.230, a category B felony, as charged in the Information, and that he be punished
22 by imprisonment in the Nevada Department of Corrections for the minimum term of ninety-
23 six (96) months to a maximum term of two hundred forty (240) months. The Defendant is
24 given two hundred ninety (290) days credit for time served.


25 A special sentence of Lifetime Supervision shall commence after any period of
26 probation, or after any term of imprisonment, or after any period of release on parole.

27 The Defendant is further ordered to pay a Three Dollar (\$3.00) administrative
28 assessment for obtaining a biological specimen and conducting a genetic marker analysis, a

1 Twenty-Five Dollar (\$25.00) administrative assessment fee, a One Hundred Fifty Dollar
2 (\$150.00) DNA analysis fee, a psychosexual evaluation fee in the amount of One Thousand
3 Six Hundred Seventy Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$1,670.70) and attorney's fees for legal
4 representation by the Washoe County Public Defender's Office in the sum of Five Hundred
5 Dollars (\$500.00) to the Clerk of the Second Judicial District Court.

6 Any fine, fee administrative assessment or restitution imposed today (as
7 reflected in this Judgment) constitutes a lien, as defined in Nevada Revised Statute NRS
8 176.275. Should the Defendant not pay these fines, fees, or assessments, collection efforts
9 may be undertaken against Travis William Bish.
