



ORDER DENYING MOTION

Appellant has filed a motion for a seventh extension of time to file the opening brief. The opposed motion is denied. *See* NRAP 31(b)(3) ("The court shall not grant additional extensions of time except upon a showing of extraordinary circumstances and extreme need."). Respondent's request to dismiss this appeal is also denied at this time. Appellant shall have 7 days from the date of this order to file and serve the opening brief and any appendix.

This appeal has been pending on this court's docket for over one year. Failure to timely file and serve the opening brief will result in the imposition of sanctions, including, but not necessarily limited to, monetary sanctions and/or the dismissal of this appeal. *See* NRAP 31(d). No further extensions of time will be granted absent demonstration of the most extraordinary circumstances and extreme need. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B).
