MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

This original petition for a writ of mandamus matter relates to a professional negligence case filed in the Eighth Judicial District Court, Case No. A-17-757722-C. On January 21, 2021, Petitioner Choloe Green ("Choloe") filed

the instant Petition for Writ of Mandamus that presented the following issues:

- Did the district court act in excess of its discretion when it granted a partial motion for summary judgment regarding Sunrise Hospital's ostensible agency relationships in defiance of the prior judge's order that a genuine issue of material fact exists for the issue to go to the jury?
- 2. Did the district court act in excess of its discretion when it refused to grant Choloe leave to amend her complaint to add ostensible agency and corporate negligence/negligent supervision as theories of liability for professional negligence based on an incorrect interpretation of NRCP 16 and the court's narrow interpretation of NRS 41A.071's affidavit requirement in violation of the statute's liberal construction?

(See Petition for Writ of Mandamus, at pp. 2-3.) This Court denied that petition. Choloe did not seeks rehearing or reconsideration at that time because writ relief is an extraordinary remedy, and Choloe respects this Court's judgment.

On August 12, 2021, however, Kia/NHG filed a Petition for Writ of Mandamus because Judge Lilly-Spells denied their motion to dismiss. (*See Kia v. Dist. Ct. (Delee)*, Case No. 83357.) Both the instant petition and the petition filed

in case number 83357 are inter-related. On November 2, 2021, Choloe filed a motion in case number 83357 because she was not served with the order directing her answer to that writ. She also requested the Court reconsider the instant petition. The Court ordered that the request was not properly made in that action.

Choloe requests permission from this Court to file her Motion for Reconsideration in light of the writ petition filed in case number 83357. Choloe believes the Court's consideration of both writ petitions is necessary to ensure the administration of justice.
