*ORDER DIRECTING ANSWER AND GRANTING STAY*

This original petition seeks a writ of mandamus directing the district court to strike a jury demand. Having reviewed the petition, it appears that an answer may assist this court in resolving this matter. Therefore, real party in interest, on behalf of respondents, shall have 28 days from the date of this order to file and serve an answer, including authorities, against issuance of the requested writ. Petitioner shall have 14 days from service of the answer to file and serve any reply.

Further, petitioner has filed a motion to stay trial pending writ review. Having considered the motion, opposition, and reply, we conclude that the relevant factors weigh in favor of the requested stay. *See* NRAP 8(c). Accordingly, we grant petitioner's motion to stay pending further order of this court.

It is so ORDERED.
