



ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO STAY ISSUANCE OF REMITTITUR

Appellant has moved to stay issuance of the remittitur pending the filing of a petition for a writ of certiorari with the United States Supreme Court. The motion is granted as follows. *Cf.* NRAP 41(b)(3). Issuance of the remittitur shall be stayed until November 9, 2022. If the clerk of this court receives written notice by November 9, 2022, from the clerk of the United States Supreme Court that appellant has filed a petition for a writ of certiorari, the stay shall continue in effect until final disposition of the certiorari proceedings. If such notice is not received by November 9, 2022, the clerk shall issue the remittitur.
