



RE: ADKT 0577; MCLE Reserves Grant Program Guidelines


Dear Chief Justice Hardesty:

On behalf of the Nevada Board of Continuing Legal Education ("CLE Board"), this letter expresses support for the MCLE Reserves Grant Program Guidelines submitted by the Board of Governors of the State Bar of Nevada on October 4, 2021.

As the Court may recall, the CLE Board submitted a letter to the Court dated February 5, 2021, regarding disposition of the CLE Board's Supreme Court Restricted Reserve and stated that a substantial portion of the Reserve should be dedicated to programs that promote diversity and inclusion, including but not limited to the development and presentation of programs of continuing legal education that cover those topics.
