

ORDER GRANTING MOTION AND REJECTING INFORMAL BRIEF

Appellant has filed a pro se letter in which he asks for an extension of time to file his appellate paperwork. The letter is treated as an untimely motion for an extension of time and, cause appearing, granted. The clerk shall file the transcript request form and docketing statement received on April 7, 2021. Appellant has also submitted an informal brief for filing. However, this appeal is subject to the provisions of NRAP 3E and requires the filing of a fast track statement rather than an informal brief. Therefore, the clerk shall return the informal brief received on April 7, 2021, unfiled. Appellant shall have 14 days from the date of this order to file and serve a fast track statement. The clerk shall provide appellant with another blank Pro Se Child Custody Fast Track Statement form. Failure to timely file and serve the fast track statement may result in the imposition of sanctions. See NRAP 3E(i).
