ORDER DIRECTING ANSWER

This original petition seeks a writ of mandamus or prohibition directing the district court to vacate its motion to strike petitioners' voluntary dismissal and prohibiting the district court from taking any further action, other than dismissal, in the case. Having reviewed the petition, it appears that an answer may assist this court in resolving this matter. Therefore, real parties in interest, on behalf of respondents, shall have 28 days from the date of this order to file and serve an answer, including authorities, against issuance of the requested writ.
