*ORDER GRANTING MOTION*

Proposed amicus Nevada Tavern Association (NTA) has filed a motion for leave to file an amicus brief in support of respondent's answering brief. NTA asserts that it is a trade association that represents the interests of tavern establishments and provides trade association insights, communications, and advocacy to its members. NTA proposes to address how the constitutionality of NRS 41.1305(1) may affect the hospitality industry in Nevada. No opposition has been filed.
