ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS

Respondents have filed motions to associate attorneys Kevin Francis Ruf and Natalie Stephanie Pang of the law firm of Glancy Prongay & Murray LLP in this matter pursuant to SCR 42. Attached to the motions to associate are verified applications, certificates of good standing from the Clerk/Executive Officer of the Supreme Court of the State of California and Supreme Court Rule 42 statements. include the original signature of at least one attorney of record who is an active member of the State Bar of Nevada).
