POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

I. STATEMENT OF FACTS

This case is a post-divorce matter involving child support for an adult who alleges a handicap which pre-dates the adult reaching the age of majority. The Appeal is related The Finding of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order filed on January 28, 2021, and the Notice of Entry of same filed on January 28, 2021. The relief granted by the District Court was a finding that Emily Reed was handicapped prior to her reaching the age of majority, which results in an Order of support from both her Mother and Father; child support arrears are owed by Appellant of \$21,500.00; and \$500.00 per month in child support from each parent commencing February 1, 2021.

A review of the Appeal file show that Counsel inadvertently failed to file proof of the "Request for Transcripts." Specifically, the transcripts were requested on February 8, 2021 and again on July 1, 2021 through the email sent to videorequests@clarkcountycourts.us.
