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POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

I. STATEMENT OF FACTS

This case is a post-divorce matter involving child support for an adult who alleges a handicap which pre-dates the adult reaching the age of majority. The Appeal is related The Finding of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order filed on January 28, 2021, and the Notice of Entry of same filed on January 28, 2021. The relief granted by the District Court was a finding that Emily Reed was handicapped prior to her reaching the age of majority, which results in an Order of support from both her Mother and Father; child support arrears are owed by Appellant of \$21,500.00; and \$500.00 per month in child support from each parent commencing February 1, 2021.

Since the filing of the Appeal there was a Supreme Court Settlement

Conference and two (2) Motions at the District Court level. Although an
agreement was not reached at the Supreme Court Settlement Conference, it was
believed upon ending same that a settlement might be possible. As such,
additional settlement attempts occurred to settle this matter; and the Motions as the
District Court level required time to prepare and litigation. Moreover, the
Appellant is struggling financially due to health-related issues and the COVID-19
pandemic. Thus, he was delayed in paying the fees for transcripts until October 1,
2021.

On October 1, 2021, Appellant paid the fees for the transcripts. Pursuant to NRAP § 9 (c)(1)(A), Verbatim Reporting was supposed to complete and deliver the transcript by November 1, 2021. Unfortunately, Verbatim Reporting has indicated that due to "experiencing massive amounts of transcript requests based on the Court's backlog" the transcripts are not complete. On November 16, 2021, Verbatim Reporting indicated it is estimated the transcripts will be ready sometime between November 22, 2021 and November 24, 2021. Furthermore, Verbatim indicated that the company is "making every effort to prepare your transcripts as fast as we possibly can. The current backlog of civil, criminal and juvenile trials, the enormous number of expedited appeals, and the reporter shortage throughout the courts is hitting all of us hard[.]"

II. ARGUMENT

NRAP § 26(b)(1)(A) states, "[f]or good cause, the court may extend the time (A) prescribed by these Rules or by its order to perform any act or may permit an act to be done after that time expires." In this matter, there is good cause to allow the Appellant additional time to obtain the transcript and file his Opening Brief in this matter. In this matter, extraordinary circumstances exist which necessitates the time be extended for filing of Appellant's Opening Brief. It appears from Verbatim Reporting that COVID-19 is having an impact on the companies ability to prepare
