## ORDER GRANTING MOTION

This court referred this pro se appeal to the Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada for screening for the appointment of pro bono counsel to represent appellant. Due to a conflict of interest, attorney Anna R. Traum, on behalf of the Pro Bono Committee of the Appellate Litigation Section, is handling the appointment of pro bono counsel. Ms. Traum has filed a motion notifying this court that she has completed eligibility screening for appellant and found him eligible for pro bono counsel, but that she has been unsuccessful locating an attorney willing to represent appellant. The deadlines to file documents in this appeal remain suspended pending further order of this court.
